



New Mexico Judicial Branch COVID-19 Court Facility Screening Questions Public

UPDATED for use on July 12, 2021

1. Within the past 10 days, have you traveled outside of the United States? (If you are a participant in a court proceeding that is occurring today or court ordered to be here, please answer "other")
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No - *Please proceed to question #2*
 - Other - *Please proceed to question #2*

2. Have you been asked by the New Mexico Department of Health to self-quarantine because of COVID-19 and are you still within the quarantine period?
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No

3. Within the past 14 days, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 by a doctor or received positive test results for COVID-19 from a testing center or by the Department of Health?
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No

4. Have you taken a COVID-19 test and are still waiting for the test results?
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No
 - Other – *You are engaged in routine testing and have approval by the Chief Judge or designee. Please proceed to question #5*

5. In the past 10 days, have you been in contact with anyone who you know has COVID-19, has traveled to New Mexico from another country, OR who is required to self-quarantine?
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No

6. Within the past 14 days, have you had a fever at or above 100.4 degrees, chills, sore throat, body aches, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, or headaches, or developed new shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, dry cough, or loss of taste or smell?
 - Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
